## Present IOLS and BALOO

### Cub Scouts - BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

This one-and-a-half-day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their pack activities. BALOO training consists of an online prerequisite component in addition to an overnight hands on practical. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. Completion of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a pack overnigher. Bring your camping gear, chair, mug and something to take notes with. Login to [my.scouting.org](http://my.scouting.org) with your account to take the online portion BEFORE arriving at camp, bring your completion certificate with you to training.

### Scouts BSA - IOLS (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills)

Instructors will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools. You will also learn about ropes and lashings, planning campfire programs, map reading, compass skills, hiking and packing techniques, nature identification, and outdoor ethics. Each outdoor session will bring to life the pages of the *Scouts BSA Handbook* to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It will increase your comfort level and give you confidence as a trained, skilled leader. The program will also give you the opportunity to work with other Scout leaders from your area, meet new friends, and reinforce skill techniques with fellow unit leaders.
