BALOO - Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation

This one day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for those leaders who are interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO is an instructor-led course which will be conducted by the Manatee District Training Team. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience.

Completion of this course is mandatory for at least one adult on a Pack overnighter.

How to Register: Online Registration. Simply go to: <http://www.swflcouncilbsa.org> and click on the calendar button on the upper left hand side of the page. Go to the date of the training in which you would like to attend and click on that training. (Registrations usually open 4 weeks prior to the event date.) Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the register button. Once you have gone through the whole process of registering, you will receive an instant confirmation of your registration.

Who: Adult BSA Cub Leaders

What to Bring: Drinking cup and folding chair.

Cancellation Policy:

Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise unable to attend an event. Since the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferrable. An exception will be made if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 72 hrs. before the date of the event. In some cases, only a partial refund can be made. Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.
