Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)

This one day course is designed to provide Scoutmasters with the basic information and tools they need to lead successful Boy Scout troops. Scoutmasters and assistant Scoutmasters who complete this course, Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills, and Youth Protection Training are considered "trained" for those positions. Learn key aspects of the BSA Scouting program including: the Patrol Method; Scout Advancement; Annual Planning; Support Team Development.

Skills Taught: Outdoor Camping Skills Ropes & Lashings, Wood Tools Camp Fires, Cooking, Land Navigation, Plant Identification, and much more!

Medical Form: All participants must bring a BSA Medical Form parts A & C or better health history to the event.

Dates & Times: Course instructions will begin at **6:00 PM on Friday October 13, 2017**, and the course will be completed by **Saturday October 14, 2017 6 PM**.
You may arrive between 5:00 PM and 6 PM to set up your tent.

Location: Camp Flying Eagle 16009 Upper Manatee River Rd, Bradenton 34212

Cost: \$20.00 for on time registration, before 10/5/17. \$25.00 for late registration after 10/5 up to 10/11/17.

How to Register: Online Registration. Simply go to: <http://www.swflcouncilbsa.org> and click on the calendar button on the upper left hand side of the page. Go to the date of the training in which you would like to attend and click on that training. (Registrations usually open 4 weeks prior to the event date.) Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the register button. Once you have gone through the whole process of registering, you will receive an instant confirmation of your registration.

Who: Adult Leaders that want to be trained for BSA Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster positions.

What to Bring: Participants will need to bring a tent, sleeping gear, personal overnight supplies, a compass and a camp chair. Bring your own Mess kit, cup/mug and eating utensils. A cook crew will prepare all meals including Friday cracker barrel and, Saturday breakfast and lunch.

Cancellation Policy: Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise unable to attend an event. Since the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferrable. An exception will be made if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 72 hrs. before the date of the event. In some cases, only a partial refund can be made. Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.
